North Carolina Virtual Public School

- NCVPS is the state's official online high school. All instruction is delivered online in a learning management system called Canvas. You will have an online teacher who will provide daily instruction and guide you through the course. NCVPS offers semester block courses and yearlong courses.
- Be aware of the workload for each:
 Block courses: about 90 minutes of work each day, Monday Friday.
 Yearlong courses: about 50 minutes of work each day, Monday Friday.
 AP Courses: about 90 minutes of work each day, Monday Friday.

Students can work on courses any time during the day or night, 24/7. Pay close attention to the due dates for the assignments, tests, and quizzes.

Summer courses: about 3-5 hours of work each day, Monday - Friday.
